#### Abstracts

#### Conference Programme

The academic programme will begin in the morning of 17 August. There will be papers on 17 August (morning + afternoon), 18 August (morning + afternoon), and 19 August (morning). The conference is expected to close around lunchtime on 19 August after a business meeting.

#### Social Programme

The social programme will include a welcome reception in the evening on 16 August and a conference dinner on 18 August. We are also planning a guided tour of Uppsala in the afternoon on 19 August.

#### Registration

### Information on Uppsala

Uppsala is Sweden's fourth largest city and is home to the oldest university in Scandinavia (founded in 1477). It is easily accessible by air, as Stockholm's main international airport, Arlanda, is located between Stockholm and Uppsala.
