## Second Circular

Dear Colleagues,

We are very much looking forward to seeing you in Uppsala in August. This second circular contains information on, among other things, registering for the conference.

### Abstracts

We have accepted a total of 40 abstracts (for papers to be delivered by one or several speakers) and one workshop with five papers. A list of the authors and topics will be available on the conference website by 18 May. We will shortly prepare a Book of Abstracts to be made available via the conference website.

### Conference Programme

The academic programme will begin in the morning of 17 August. There will be papers on 17 August (morning + afternoon), 18 August (morning + afternoon), and 19 August (morning). The conference is expected to close around lunchtime on 19 August after a business meeting.

### Social Programme

The social programme will include a welcome reception in the evening on 16 August, a conference dinner on 18 August, and a guided tour of Uppsala in the afternoon on 19 August. It will be possible to sign up for these events when you register for the conference.

## Registration

It is now possible to register for LMEC 6. Please follow the link on the conference website to register. Please note that there is a reduced early-bird fee that will be available until 27 June.

## Information on Uppsala

Uppsala is Sweden's fourth largest city and is home to the oldest university in Scandinavia (founded in 1477). It is easily accessible by air, as Stockholm's main international airport, Arlanda, is located between Stockholm and Uppsala. A map of downtown Uppsala that highlights the conference venue, the two hotels that we have made arrangements with, Uppsala Central Station, and the venue for the conference dinner is available on the conference website. ## Accommodation

We have coordinated with two hotels within walking distance of the conference venue to offer a discounted rate for rooms:

- Hotel Von Kraemer (400 m from the conference venue) is offering a number of single rooms for SEK 1,235 per night; remaining rooms (single or double occupancy) are offered at SEK 1,350 per night.
