### **Third Circular**

Dear Colleagues,

We are very much looking forward to seeing you in Uppsala in a few days. This third circular contains some additional information on the conference.

#### Conference Programme

The academic programme will begin in the morning of 17 August. It will be possible to register for the conference between 8.30am and 9.00am; there will also be opportunities to register later in the day. There will be papers on 17 August (morning + afternoon), 18 August (morning + afternoon), and 19 August (morning). The conference will close around lunchtime on 19 August. All rooms in which papers will be presented are equipped with a computer and a projector. An updated programme and Book of Abstracts will be published on the conference website shortly.

Note that the conference fee includes coffee breaks on 17–19 August, cooked lunches on 17 and 18 August, and a sandwich lunch on 19 August. All coffee breaks and lunches will be provided at the conference venue, Campus Blåsenhus (please see the map on the conference website for the location of the conference venue).

#### Social Programme

The social programme will include the following events:

- A welcome reception at the English Park Campus at 6pm on 16 August. Please see the town map on the LMEC 6 website for the location of the campus. A map of the campus is included at the end of this circular. Please go to entrance 3H or entrance 3R to get to

the reception (entrance 3H is marked on the map; entrance 3R is opposite 3H); in the elevator, press “3” to get to the right floor.

- A conference dinner at Östgöta Nation (street address: Trädgårdsgatan 15) at 6pm on 18 August. A welcome drink will be served at 6pm; guests will be invited to take their seats at 6.30pm. **Important:** if you made a dietary request when you registered for the dinner, please contact the bar staff before you take your seat. You will be given a note with your request which you can show to the waiting staff so that they can make sure you get the right food.
- A guided tour of Uppsala in the afternoon on 19 August. The tour will begin at Uppsala Castle at 1pm and end at 3.15pm. Those who have signed up for the tour can follow one of the conference organizers from the conference venue to Uppsala Castle.

Note that all three events are included in the conference fee. However, each event is open only to delegates who registered for the event in question when they registered for the conference.

#### Information on Uppsala

Uppsala is Sweden’s fourth largest city and is home to the oldest university in Scandinavia (founded in 1477).
